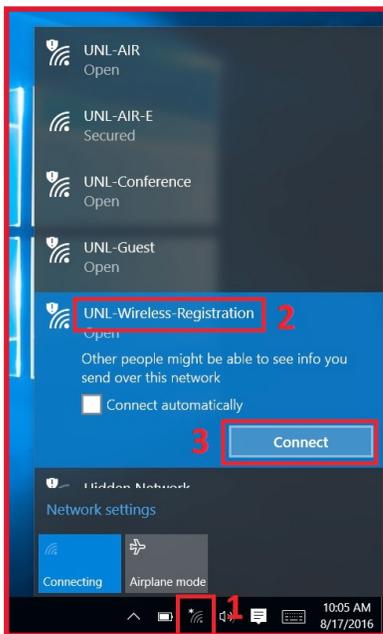




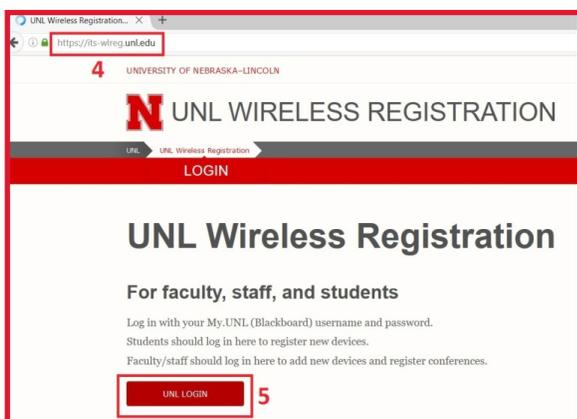
Windows – Connecting to WiFi

1. In the lower right corner, by the clock, click on the wireless icon.
2. A pop-up of all the wireless networks in the area will appear, click on **UNL-Wireless-Registration**.
3. Make sure that the **Connect automatically** box is unchecked then click the **Connect** button.

Sometimes the connection will not work right away so you might need to do steps 1-3 another time.



4. Open a web browser and navigate to <http://its-wlreg.unl.edu>.
5. Click on the **UNL Login** button under **For Faculty, staff, and students**.



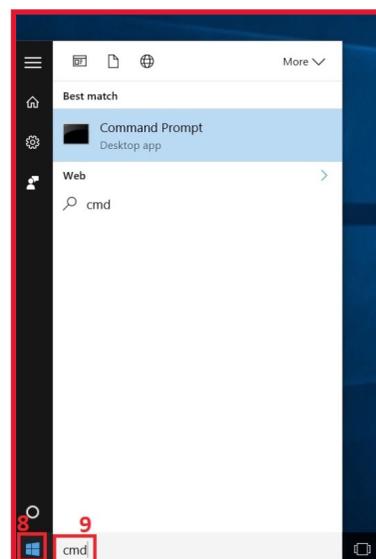
6. You'll be prompted to enter in your credentials; meaning your student Blackboard account information, then click the login button.



7. When the wireless registration page loads, click on **Register a device**.

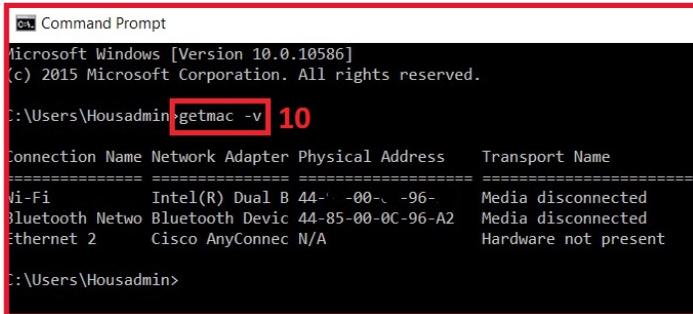


8. Click on the windows button in the lower left corner.
9. When the windows menu opens, type **CMD** and hit enter.





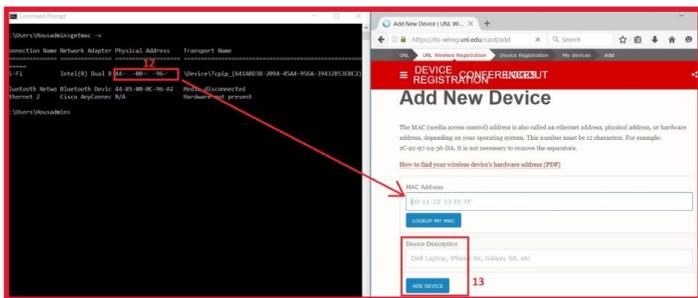
10. When the **Command Prompt** window loads, type in **getmac -v**.



11. Move the windows around so you can see the **Command Prompt** window and your web browser window at the same time.

12. In the **Command Prompt** window, you should have some alpha/numeric characters for **Wi-Fi** under the **Physical Address** column. Enter these numbers on the **Add New Device** site under the **MAC Address** field.

13. Enter a brief description of your device then click the **Add Device** button.

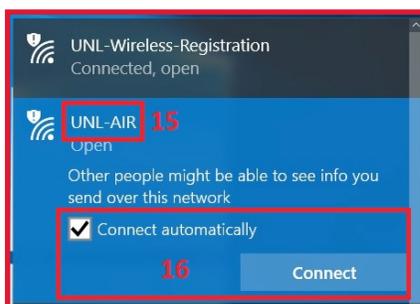


14. In the lower right corner, by the clock, click on the wireless icon.



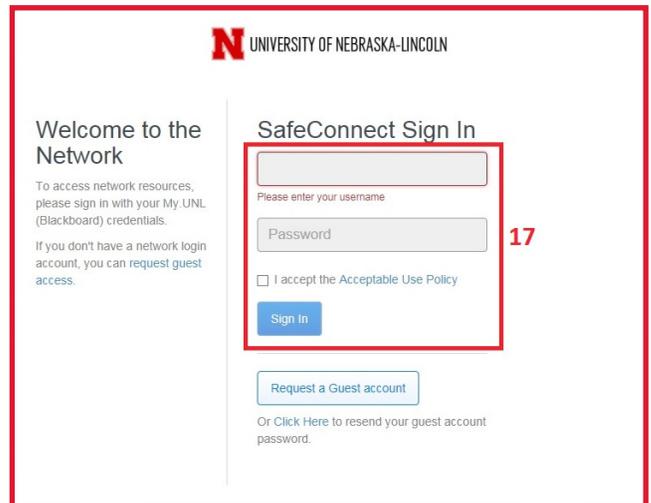
15. A pop up of all the wireless networks in the areas will appear, click on **UNL-AIR**.

16. Make sure that the **Connect automatically** box is checked then click the **Connect** button.



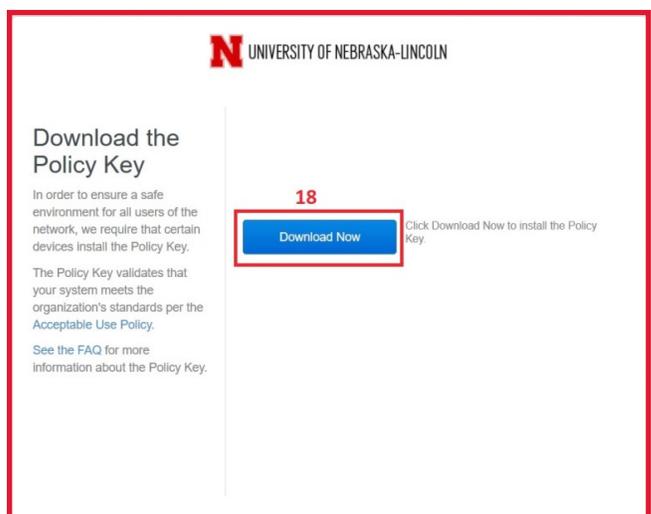
17. Open a new web browser window or tab. You should be prompted to enter in **SafeConnect** credentials (enter your student Blackboard account information). Check the **I accept** box, then click the **Sign In** button.

After opening a new web browser window or tab, if you are not auto navigated to the **SafeConnect** sign-in page, then please navigate to its.unl.edu/safeconnect.



18. After logging in, you should be directed to a page explaining the **SafeConnect Policy Key** and a download link. **Click the download button**.

After clicking the download button, navigate to where you saved the installer and run it; you may get some prompts about verification, click the buttons that will allow the application to run.



19. Follow the on screen instructions to install the Policy Key. Once it's installed, go back to the web browser and click the **I'm done installing** button. If your machine is up-to-date, you should get a prompt that the process is complete and you can connect to the Internet. *Otherwise, move on to the next step.*



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Install Policy Key

In order to ensure a safe environment for all users of the network, we require that certain devices install the Policy Key.

The Policy Key validates that your system meets the network's security standards as per the school's Acceptable Use Policy.

Follow the instructions below to complete the installation.

- 1 Save the file to your preferred directory.
- 2 After the download is complete, navigate to the file and run it.
- 3 Follow the instructions on the installer.
- 4 Click "I'm done installing" below.
