

# PACKING CHECKLIST

## We Provide

- Extra-long twin bed and extra-long mattress
- Closet(s)
- Desk and chair
- Refrigerator/freezer combination (except Love Memorial)
- Mirrored medicine cabinets or personal mirrors
- Roll shades or blinds/curtains
- Wastebasket and recycle bin
- Wired and wireless high-speed Internet connectivity

## Items You'll Need

- Your NCard (NU ID)
- Twin-size sheets (Extra-long and deep-pocket sheets will all work on our mattresses. All beds are 39" x 80" and require extra-long bed sheets. Kauffman beds are 34" x 80," Selleck beds are 36" x 80".)
- Bedspread or comforter, blankets
- Pillow and pillowcase
- Towels and washcloths
- Shower tote/caddy/robe/shower shoes
- Toiletries (soap, shampoo, toothbrush, etc.)
- Clothes hangers
- Backpack
- Season-appropriate clothing (switch out during breaks)
- Umbrella/raincoat
- Surge protectors
- Social Security card (for employment purposes)
- Insurance and pharmacy cards
- Prescription refills (including eye care)
- Current prescription medications in their original containers
- Information: physician's name(s), address, telephone number and emergency telephone numbers
- 25 ft. Ethernet cable (available for purchase at UNL Computer Store)
- High-efficiency laundry detergent
- Courtyards/Village residents will also need to bring kitchen items such as pots, pans and dishes.

\*A note about used/second-hand items. Anything you have bought, borrowed or picked up second-hand may be harboring bed bugs. Our advice is, if you aren't sure something doesn't have bugs - don't bring it.

## Useful Items

- Laundry basket/iron
- Cleaning supplies
- Flashlight and batteries
- Personal computer with updated security
- Portable fan
- Checkbook/debit card
- Pictures, posters and other decorative items (only use approved adhesives such as 3M Command adhesives and blue painter's tape)
- Desk/floor lamps (Avoid Halogen lamps)
- Cooking appliances approved for use must be UL-approved and must comply with the small appliance policy\*

## Items You Should Not Bring

- Candles
- Drums and amplified guitars
- Electric skillets and electric grills (i.e. George Foreman grill)
- Any appliance with open heating coils
- Any non-university bed frame or loft
- Space heaters
- Microwaves and small appliances rated above 800 watts
- Unapproved materials for hanging including Scotch, duct, electrical or masking tape; gum-type adhesives, tacks, nails and staples; anything else that might damage walls/doors/floors

## Items Subject to Disciplinary action

- Alcohol, illegal drugs and/or prescription drugs that do not belong to the student
- Decorated alcohol containers
- Candles/incense
- Weapons or ammunition (firearms, martial arts weapons, knives, paint ball guns, etc.)
- Pets (other than fish)
- Fireworks/other explosives
- Tobacco-free and smoke-free campus policy: To provide a healthy environment that promotes the wellness and safety of students, faculty, staff and visitors, NU and the University of Nebraska-Lincoln prohibit smoking and the use of tobacco products in and on all university property.
- For traditional halls only: any cooking appliance(s) not listed as approved which include, but are not limited to, toaster ovens, hot plates, George Foreman grills and any non-UL-listed appliances.

- Microwave (800 watt maximum), if you are assigned to Abel, Harper, Sandoz, Schramm, Selleck, or Smith

- Futon/small couch
- Carpet/rug
